Volunteer Telephone Adviser

Location: Ilkeston

Days: Monday to Friday, 10am - 2pm

Minimum commitment per week: 4 hours



The role:

The role entails giving information and advice to the public via our Adviceline. You will join a team of over 20 volunteers and 7 paid members of staff and be supported throughout the process by a skilled supervisor.

Adviceline acts as the first port of call for many of our clients and a lifeline for those in crisis situations. You will deal with a range of issues including benefits, debt, housing, energy, relationships and much more. Full training and coaching will be provided as part of the role.

The role is located in our Ilkeston office on Heanor Road, we have a full phone room set up and all relevant equipment including laptop and headsets are provided.

Volunteer Face to Face Adviser

Location: Ilkeston, Heanor, Matlock, Buxton or Glossop

Days: Varies by location

Minimum commitment per week: 6 hours

The role:

The role entails giving advice to the general public on a wide range of issues including benefits, debt, housing, employment, relationships and much more.

As a face to face adviser you will see clients in one of our office locations and deliver advice to those most in need in the heart of your community.

All our volunteers are supported by skilled supervisors and full training and coaching is provided throughout.

The days and times of our services differ by location, so get in touch to find out more.

Volunteer Energy Adviser

Location: Ilkeston, Matlock, Buxton or remote from home

Days: Tues, Wed, Thurs, 10am - 2pm

Minimum commitment per week: 4 hours

The role:

The role entails giving information and advice to the general public on energy related issues and income maximisation. You will join our dispersed team of energy advisers working across Derbyshire giving one to one advice to people in need.

You can expect to advise on energy efficiency measures, tariffs and meters, home improvement measures, grants and schemes available and benefits advice. Full training and coaching is provided on all relevant topics and skills required.

The role can be face to face, telephone or a mixture, and all advice giving is supported by a skilled supervisor. All relevant equipment including laptop and headsets are provided.
